

## **6.1 -- RELATIONS WITH PARENTS' ORGANIZATIONS**

The Board of Education recognizes the valuable services performed by the various parent organizations whose objectives are:

1. To promote the welfare of children and youth.
2. To raise the standards of home life.
3. To secure adequate laws for the care and protection of children and youth.
4. To bring into closer relationship, the home and the school, to enable parents and teachers to cooperate intelligently in the training of the child.
5. To develop between educators and the general public such united efforts as will secure for every child the highest advantages for an education.

The Board further suggests that each such organization maintain a close liaison with the Board, administration, and staff that there may be recognition and support of established school district policies.
