King Elementary Title 1 Report

I. Purpose of Title I

The purpose of Title I is to ensure that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and state academic assessments.

Definition of Title I

- Title I provides federal funding to schools to help students who are low achieving or at most risk of falling behind.
- Title I is allocated to schools based on the percentage of students receiving free/reduced lunch.
- Schools with a percentage of at least 40% free/reduced lunch are eligible for a schoolwide program.

King Elementary Operates a

Title I Schoolwide Program

- Title I funds are used to serve all children in order to raise the academic achievement.
- Title I funds will be used to provide additional assistance to all students who experience difficulties in meeting the state's performance targets.

Schoolwide Schools Must:

- The school must have a free/reduced lunch count of at least 40%. In 2023-24 King was at 84%.
- The school must collect and analyze data that affects student achievement.
- The school must develop a comprehensive site plan and annually review the effectiveness of the plan.

II. Parent's Rights Under Title I

- As a parent you have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of the classroom staff (certified and noncertified paraprofessionals) working with your child.
- If at any time your student has been taught for four consecutive weeks by a teacher that is not highly qualified, then you will be notified by the school.




